# Adopt-A-Classroom Project

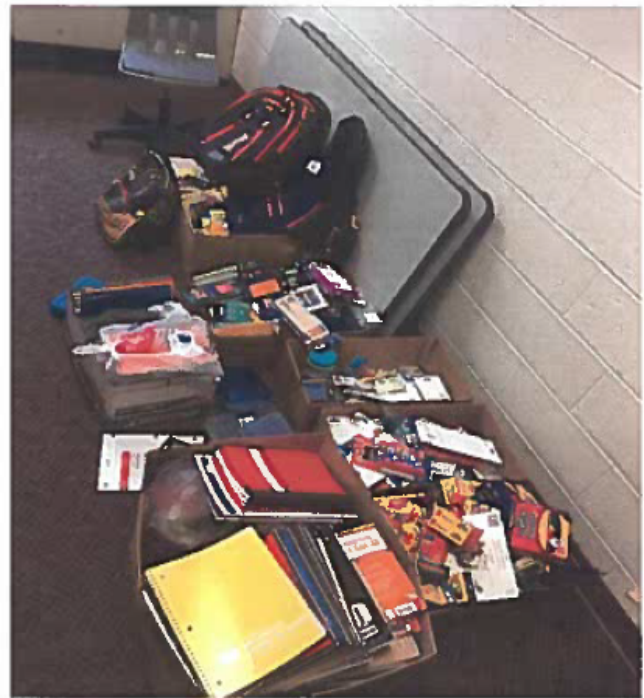
