

Hagan Scholarship

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship. The scholarship is designed to help recipients graduate college debt free. Recipients must graduate from a public high school located in a county in the United States having fewer than 50,000 residents. The scholarship provides up to \$6,000 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters.

Purpose

The Purpose of the Hagan Scholarship is to provide each recipient with the opportunity to obtain a four-year college education and graduate debt free. And, to provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically taught as a part of the school curriculum. These skills are taught via Workshops, Schwab Brokerage Accounts, and Study Abroad.

Recipient Responsibilities

1. Must graduate college within four years.
2. Must achieve a 3.00 GPA each semester and maintain a 3.25 CGPA after the first semester.
3. Must complete fourteen on-campus GPA credit hours each fall semester.
4. Must complete thirty on-campus GPA credit hours each academic year, excluding summer school.
5. Must fulfill ALL Recipient Responsibilities.

2019-20 Scholarship Timeline

1. Application available September 1, 2019.
2. **Application Deadline November 15, 2019.**
3. Application reviewed for completeness, compliance with instructions, eligibility.
4. Finalists provide supplemental information in February 2020.
5. Finalist applications read, evaluated, ranked in March 2020.
6. Scholarships awarded by the Grant Committee in April 2020.

Historically, about 40% of eligible applicants are awarded scholarships. The highest award percentage by far of any national scholarship.
