

The United Steelworkers Hugh Carcella Scholarship Program offers scholarships each year with a total value of \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year for four years). Scholarships will be awarded in June 2020.

Eligibility

An applicant must be the son or daughter or legal ward of a member of the United Steelworkers, District 10 in good standing with the local union participating in the Scholarship Program; or the son or daughter or legal ward of a disabled or old age retiree or deceased member of an affiliated local union who was in good standing with the United Steelworkers at the time of their retirement or death.

***** To be eligible for the award, applicant must be in the graduating class of the year the scholarships are awarded. Applicants who have graduated high school or completed one semester or more at any college or university are ineligible. *****

How to Apply

Application may be obtained, upon request, from participating local unions. Applicants will fill out the application form giving all required information. No application will be accepted unless properly signed by the President and Recording Secretary of the respective local union. When completed, the forms should be mailed to the Scholarship Fund Committee, United Steelworkers, 10 Canal Street, Bristion, PA 19007.

Closing Date

Applications must be postmarked no later than midnight, March 15, 2020. There are no exceptions to this rule and applications postmarked after the March 15 date will be returned ineligible.
