

Selinsgrove Area School District's Plan for Reopening Educational Options

It is the goal of the Selinsgrove Area School District to provide families with as much flexibility as possible for students' safe return to school. Below is a description of each educational option being provided by the Selinsgrove Area School District. All students will be provided with a district-issued device to support each educational option.

In-Person

- This model provides Selinsgrove Area School District students the opportunity to attend school daily, in-person.
- Various health and safety measures will be implemented to maximize student safety and mitigate risk.
- All students will continually utilize online learning resources to ensure a continuity of education throughout the year.
- This model allows for a seamless transition to distance learning if a family desires a change in educational model or if the need arises due to illness or need to quarantine.
- All schools will run on a 1-Hour Delayed Schedule to start the school year.
 - o This adjusted schedule:
 - reduces the quantity of time that students are in proximity to one another for extended periods of time.
 - provides an opportunity for faculty to generate impactful learning opportunities for students participating In-Person and through Distance Learning.
 - allows all district staff to ensure that cleaning and sanitizing procedures are completed prior to students entering the buildings.
- Students will continue to have access to all supports and services provided by the Selinsgrove Area School District.

Distance Learning

- Students will have the choice to fully participate in the regular curriculum via online learning platforms through <u>asynchronous (recorded lessons and posted activities) instruction with synchronous (live or real-time) engagement opportunities</u> facilitated by Selinsgrove Area School District teachers and staff.
 - o By participating in the full, regular curriculum, students will be exposed to all content and have the ability to engage in all activities for each course/grade level.
 - o This participation will include being assessed regularly for students to receive traditional grades that reflect student achievement.
- This allows parents the option for students to remain at-home while fully participating in grade-level content or coursework.
- Students may choose to participate in-person for a portion of the day or to attend specific classes. (This should occur on a regular or predictable basis.)
 - o This model allows for a seamless transition to In-Person instruction if a family desires a change in educational model or if the need arises.
- Students will continue to have access to all supports and services provided by the Selinsgrove Area School District.

Selinsgrove Area School District Full-Year Cyber Option

- This is similar to our current Middle School and High School Hybrid models, but also offered at the K-5 level.
- Selinsgrove Area School District students will participate in grade-level and course offerings provided through an Edmentum (9-12) or eToole learning platform (Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit).
- Courses are designed to be completed in their entirety as the curricular activities do not directly align with SASD instruction.
 - o It is preferred to complete an entire course before transitioning to In-Person or Distance Learning.
- Students will continue to have access to all supports and services provided by the Selinsgrove Area School District.
- * The "In-Person" and "Distance Learning" options are designed for students to seamlessly transition from one to the other in the event of a school closure, the need for a student to quarantine, or if you have an increased desire to have your child socially distance.
