

Dear Parent/Guardian-

This letter is being sent to provide clarification regarding the expectations for our full-time distance learners and cyber-school students regarding PSSA testing in May.

1. We ask that students arrive no later than 9:45 a.m. on testing days. Please have your child report to the main office and they will be escorted to a separate testing location. We ask that students wear a face covering and bring a water bottle with them.

The testing dates are as follows:

	English Language Arts and Reading	Math	Science
Grade 3	May 10, 11 and 12	May 18 and 19	
Grade 4	May 3, 4 and 5	May 10 and 11	May 18 and 19
Grade 5	May 3, 4 and 5	May 12 and 13	

2. Students will be provided essential materials for the testing including pencils, calculators, scratch paper, etc.
3. The testing sessions for each day will run from 9:45 -11:45 each morning. Please keep in mind that students have as much time as needed to complete each section, so they may have extended time past 11:45, if necessary. We will have a sign-in sheet available in the office. Please provide us with a contact number and we will let you know once your child is finished testing.
4. Students may pack a lunch or purchase a lunch (lunches are provided at no cost to the families this year) and eat with their classmates if they would like to do so on testing days. If the weather is nice, the students typically eat outside. Please indicate on the sign-in sheet each day if your child is planning on eating lunch at school.
