#### **Community Giving Foundation: Sunbury—Health Profession Scholarships\***

Community Giving Foundation: Sunbury offers scholarships to students who reside in the Shikellamy, Selinsgrove, and Line Mountain school districts through the Sunbury Area Health Fund. Students must be majoring in a health profession field, broadly defined to encompass the many and varied health-related careers ranging from nursing and dental assistant to health education, allied health, and therapy, to dentistry and medicine. Enrollment can be in an undergraduate, graduate, or certification program at an institution of higher education. Students at any phase in their post-secondary education can apply. This scholarship is not limited to graduating high school seniors or "new" students. Applicants must apply for financial aid which they are eligible for (ex. PHEAA). Scholarship amounts will be determined on an individual basis.

#### **John A. Bolig Seals Alumni Scholarship Fund\***

This scholarship is available to high school seniors or graduates (alumni) of Selinsgrove School District, who will be enrolled in a post-secondary program (certification, courses, associate, bachelor's degree) at an institution of higher education or technical school. Special consideration is given to students who are pursuing a technical career (including heating, plumbing, etc.). This is a one-year award.

#### **Madelyn L. Whitmer Education Scholarship Fund**

Provide scholarships to Selinsgrove Area High School graduating seniors pursuing a teaching career. Consideration will be given to good students demonstrating a strong work ethic, financial need, and who has experience with community service. The student does not necessarily need to be a straight A student.

**Orlando C. Scopelliti Scholarship Fund\***

Available for high school graduates from any school district within the Foundation's service area (Columbia, Lower-Luzerne, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties) entering degree programs for the care and/or education of the mentally and physically challenged. Students are eligible to apply upon acceptance to a qualified program for a bachelor's, associate, or technical degree. This is a one-year award.

**Patricia H. and Richard E. Garman Scholarship Fund\***

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors or graduates (alumni) from Selinsgrove High School who are attending a post-secondary school for a 2-year degree, 4-year degree, or certification, at a university or trade school. Consideration given to students who demonstrate financial need.

**Roger S. and Lois W. Haddon Nursing Scholarship Fund\***

Provide scholarships for high school graduate(s) of the Danville, Lewisburg, Shikellamy, and Selinsgrove school districts who are pursuing nursing degrees. Past recipients may apply for the following year. One or more awards may be granted annually, provided the Foundation award minimum is met for each award.

**Selinsgrove Rotary/Selinsgrove Area Scholarship Fund\***

Community Giving Foundation: Selinsgrove and Selinsgrove Area Rotary Club offer scholarships to qualifying high school graduating seniors from Selinsgrove High School and SUN Area Technical Institute who pursue a 2- or 4-year program or degree at an accredited post-secondary institution. Special consideration given to student's academic achievement, financial need and potential for success in their education. Selinsgrove and Rotary take great pride in being able to help students achieve their undergraduate goals and see them move on to become leaders in business and professional careers. Rotary's motto is "Service Above Self", and past and current recipients are proving this to be true with their volunteer involvement in school/community activities and organizations.

**Simon B. and Kathryn Rhoads Family Scholarship Fund\***

This scholarship is available to high school seniors or graduates (alumni) of the Selinsgrove Area School District. Preference will be given to students pursuing higher education in a field of study related to agriculture, in a two- or four-year program. This is a one-year award.

**Steven and Judith Bottiger Scholarship Fund\***

This scholarship is available to second, third-, and fourth-year undergraduate students attending an accredited Bachelor of Architecture degree program at one of the following schools: Carnegie Mellon University, Drexel University, Lehigh University, Marywood University, Penn State University, or University of Pennsylvania. Preference is given for graduates of Lewisburg, Midd-West, Mifflinburg, or Selinsgrove School Districts.

**To Celebrate the Life of Patients of Cancer Care of Central Pennsylvania Fund**

Provided to a Selinsgrove High School senior who attains the highest GPA in Biology and is pursuing a post-secondary education. (No application)

**Wayne and Nancy Van Kirk Scholarship Fund\***

This scholarship is available to high school graduates from Selinsgrove High School who have participated in extracurricular activities and/or community service and will be entering a trade, technical, LPN, business, computer, certificate and/or similar associate degree program. The applicant must also demonstrate a financial need and have a minimum GPA of 2.0 (based on a 4.0 scale). This is a one-year scholarship award.
