## APPLYING TO COLLEGE:

1. Apply through the Common Application to participating colleges: ([commonapp.org](http://commonapp.org))  
College Application, transcript and letter of recommendation all are managed by Common Application through secure emails. (Provide the letter of recommendation form completed in Career Prep to your recommenders.)

**OR**

2. a. Apply directly to each college on the college website.  
b. Send a transcript to each school through [Parchment.com](http://Parchment.com)  
(Your Parchment account was created while in Career Prep.)  
c. If needed, request letters of recommendation from counselor and/or teachers.  
(Provide letter of recommendation form completed in Career Prep to your recommenders.)

**NCAA** (National Collegiate Athletic Association): Information and forms for applying are online at [www.eligibilitycenter.org](http://www.eligibilitycenter.org). You need to request your transcript by using the Parchment site.

**SAT TEST** – Information and registration is available at [sat.org](http://sat.org). Refer to the College Board website or see your counselor for registration deadlines (approx. 4 weeks prior to test date). The CEEB/ACT code listed above is very important when registering and the test center number is 39642. Eligible students may receive a fee waiver. See your counselor for details. It's recommended that you test at least once during your junior year and again at the beginning of your senior year.
