Summer School Enrollment Information

DURATION: 6 weeks - **June 9 through July 17, 2025**: Some classes may need to meet more than two times in one week and skip a week due to certain teacher obligations or the July 4th holiday. This will be worked out with students on the first day of classes.

TIME: The school building will be open from 7 am to 4 pm. Computer labs will be monitored for student use from 8 – 12 Monday through Thursday.

Student instruction/class time for full credit classes from 8 am to 12 noon Half credit classes – These classes will meet on assigned days from 8 am to 2 pm and will require additional work at home in between class meetings.

Full credit classes – These classes will meet for 4 hours two times per week. If a student is enrolled in two classes that meet the same day, the teachers will work out an acceptable schedule for the student to meet their obligation for both classes.

COURSES TO BE OFFERED:

As Credit Recovery Only (After Failing a Course During the 24-25 School Year): FULL CREDIT COURSES

English I, English II, English IV Algebra I, Algebra II, Keystone Algebra, Geometry Biology, Integrated Science (9th Grade Science), Environmental Science WAHG 1, WAHG 2, Civics

Credit Recovery OR Advancement: HALF CREDIT COURSES

Career Prep Personal Finance (Recovery Only)

Students are eligible for summer school classes if they had a 45% or higher as their final course grade. For students who are taking a course for credit recovery, there will be a "reteach, retest" approach to the course. The summer school instructor will examine the scores the student had during the regular school year and will find where the student did not do well. During the summer school classes, the student will be retaught the

information and then retest. The re-teaching may be done by the teacher OR the student may work on material through a PLATO course for additional instruction. There will be some offline work required, and this will be done with teachers during the class meeting times.

As soon as a student completes the course successfully by attaining a passing grade of 60% or above, they will no longer be required to attend class. Students may be able to take pre-tests on material which may exempt them from certain activities.

COST TO STUDENTS:

Selinsgrove Students:

There will be no cost to the student for summer school for this year. There may be some limitations with enrollment based on demand. We encourage the application to be turned in as soon as possible.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CLASSES: Students are only able to take the equivalent of 2 credits. This could be two full credit courses for recovery purposes OR one full credit course for recovery and 2 half credits for recovery/advancement. This limit may be waived if individual circumstances warrant additional credits (SUN Tech Requirements, summer graduation, etc.).

BUSINESS COURSES: Students taking a business summer course must attend all the class sessions listed below to earn credit for the course for advancement.
