MARCH SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: March 16, 2026 & April 15, 2026

1) **Microsoft Disability Scholarship** - \$20,000 - 11 Awards (Deadline: March 16, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a current high school senior.

B) Pursue a degree in one the following majors: Engineering, Computer Science, Computer Information Systems, Law, Business, Paralegal, Pre-Law, Finance, Business Administration, or Marketing.

2) **Hillel General Scholarships** - \$18,000 - 60 Awards (Deadline: March 16, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Self-identify as Jewish.

B) Have a GPA of 2.5 or above.

3) **HITEC Foundation Scholarship Program** - \$5,000 - 35 Awards (Deadline: March 16, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be of Hispanic/Latinx heritage.

B) Be a graduating high school senior or current undergraduate/graduate student.

4) Microsoft Women Scholarship - \$5,000 - 16 Awards (Deadline: March 16, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a female and in senior year of high school.
- B) Plan to enroll full-time in a technology, engineering, math, or computer science-related undergraduate degree at an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical school in the United States.

5) Truman D. Picard Scholarship - \$4,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: March 20, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a Native American pursuing a higher education in Natural Resources.
- B) Be a graduating high school senior or current undergraduate/graduate student.

6) CBC Spouses Visual Arts Scholarship - \$20,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: March 27, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be an African American/Black graduating high school senior.
- B) Be enrolled in a nationally or regionally accredited undergraduate or graduate institution by the Fall of 2026.

7) Educational Foundation for Women in Accounting - \$10,000 - 8 Awards (Deadline: March 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to pursue a business degree, preference given to those focused on accounting.
- B) Be a woman and have financial need.

8) Society of Women Engineers Scholarship - \$10,000 - 330 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be studying engineering, technology or computing in the upcoming academic year.
- B) Be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree.

9) Latino Actuaries Scholarship Program - \$7,500 - 31 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be attending a US college/university next school year.
- B) Have interest in pursuing a career in the actuarial profession.

10) Beyond the Cure Ambassador Scholarship - \$3,500 – 50 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a childhood cancer survivor under the age of 25 and diagnosed before the age of 18.
- B) Be accepted into a post-secondary school for the fall semester of the upcoming academic year.

11) Hard of Hearing or Deaf Scholarship - \$1,000 - 40 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have a minimum 40dB bilateral hearing loss, as evidenced on audiogram by SRT & PTA scores.
- B) Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate student pursuing four-year college degree.

12) Young American Creative Patriotic Scholarship - \$10,000 – 8 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school in the United States or be a dependent of U.S. military or civilian personnel in an overseas school.

B) Be in grades 9-12.

13) American Nuclear Society Scholarship - \$5,000 - 96 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a graduating high school senior who has enrolled full-time in college and is pursuing science, technology, engineering, or mathematics with an interest in working in nuclear science and technology.

14) Vicki Soto Memorial Scholarship - \$12,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a full-time senior student graduating in the spring of 2026.

B) Intend to pursue a career in education at an accredited college.

15) Water Ski Foundation Scholarships - \$10,000 – 27 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be an incoming freshman through senior at a two or four year accredited college or university.

B) Participate in the sport of water skiing, as a rider, volunteer, or official.

16) Chief Petty Officer Scholarship - \$5,000 - 52 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a dependent child, stepchild of a US Navy Active Duty, Retired, Honorably Discharged, Reserve, or deceased Chief, Senior Chief, or Master Chief Petty Officer of the United States Navy.

B) Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate student pursuing four-year college degree.

17) Educational Theatre Association Scholarships - \$2,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a graduating high school senior.

B) Be currently participating in Theatre or Film in school or the community.

18) Jack Terry Memorial Scholarship - \$2,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: April 6, 2026)

B) Have overcome hardships or adversity in their lives.

19) Airmen Memorial Foundation Scholarship Program - \$5,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: April 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Be a child or stepchild of an active duty, retired or veteran member of USAF, ANG or AFRC.
