Minutes: (Extracurricular Discussion Topics)

***High School Gymnasium Upgrades**

Dr. Jankowski mentioned that the HS gym floor is the 1955 original floor. Before replacing the floor, considerations need to be made regarding:

- Painting – Consideration on painting the gym to preference before installing any flooring.
- HVAC – Making sure humidity levels can be regulated to support the new floor.
- Floor – Proposed time frame would be Spring/Summer of 2027

***Tennis Court Upgrades**

Dr. Jankowski briefed the attendees on the updated information regarding the resurfacing of the tennis courts with the option of expanding the courts. There was a question asking why additional courts are needed. It was stated that the additional courts would allow the matches to run at a better pace and therefore get done in a timelier manner. Options would need to be addressed with an engineer along with the feasibility study report expansion considered. Proposed time frame for this project is also 2027.

***Feedback from the Coaches Regarding Practice & Playing Surfaces**

Coaches' feedback was they would like more practice time on the turf. Consideration will be addressed in the upcoming feasibility study. Board needs to look at the feasibility study submissions to decide if or which ones they want to consider and/or accept.

***Fundraising at Stadium Events with Emphasis on Friday night football games**

Board member Dave Hess opened the discussion with information he gathered regarding the football program. David Watto then thanked the Athletic Council and Football Boosters for the support they offer the students.

Dr. Jankowski opened it up to the attendees to start the discussion with the main concerns being food trucks may not be the best way to acquire funds, and Football Boosters want to be able to raise money at their own event. Mr. Davis from the Athletic Council offered to start the discussion. His concern is that the food trucks are making money that could be allotted to our students. He said that if football parents would work in the Athletic Council stand, they would receive more income than they did with the food trucks. Erica Amato stated that there is no consistency and quality when it comes to the football program fundraising opportunities within the stadium. Discussion regarding parents getting more credit working a Friday night in the Athletic Council stand when football parents want to watch their students play, charging a percentage previously when working the extra concession stand in stadium, and not allowing duplicate menu items within stands made it impossible for them to succeed and feel valued when they previously ran a stand in the stadium. SASD School Board members promoted compromise and the start of a new culture of younger football groups stepping in to work Friday nights so varsity parents can watch their student athlete play. They proposed getting football volunteers to work at the Athletic Council stand with credit being the same for any event worked.

They also asked the Football Boosters if they would be willing to run the extra concession stand in the stadium and if so, would they have the volunteers to run it? Erica Amato said she would need to talk to the parents involved and would need more information on cost of running the stand, equipment purchases needed to run the stand, and menu items. The board expressed how much they value each program and would like a resolution at the next board meeting. The recommendation is for the football boosters to contact Dr. Jankowski within the next 2 weeks.

***Other Topics to Discuss:**

HS PA System was mentioned and stated that it needs to be replaced this summer.

Dave Hess acknowledged Wyatt Teats, Selinsgrove football athlete, who suffered a knee injury that kept him from playing his last year, but is now doing well, participating in track and will be attending Penn State University to pursue a career in Engineering.

Dave Hess also introduced Tim Wolfe – Manager of Buffalo Wild Wings. He expressed his desire to donate financially with the prospect of getting other businesses involved.

***Community Discussion: Pool Parking Lot Discussion**

SASD School Board members reviewed a proposal provided by Mr. Rick Mease of the Selinsgrove Area Pool Association in regard to paving the parking lot at the pool. The SASD school board expressed general support but desires to include some acknowledgements in the agreement with the pool association in an effort to guarantee maximum safety requirements and maintenance of the newly impacted ground.

***High School Cafeteria HVAC Bids**

The deadline is May 5th for the HVAC bids. The results will be provided at the May 11th board meeting.

***Feasibility Study**

The feasibility study proposals have been turned in by several groups. No bid has been awarded. The information needs to be compiled and provided to the school board. The SASD School Board will then decide what to do moving forward.
